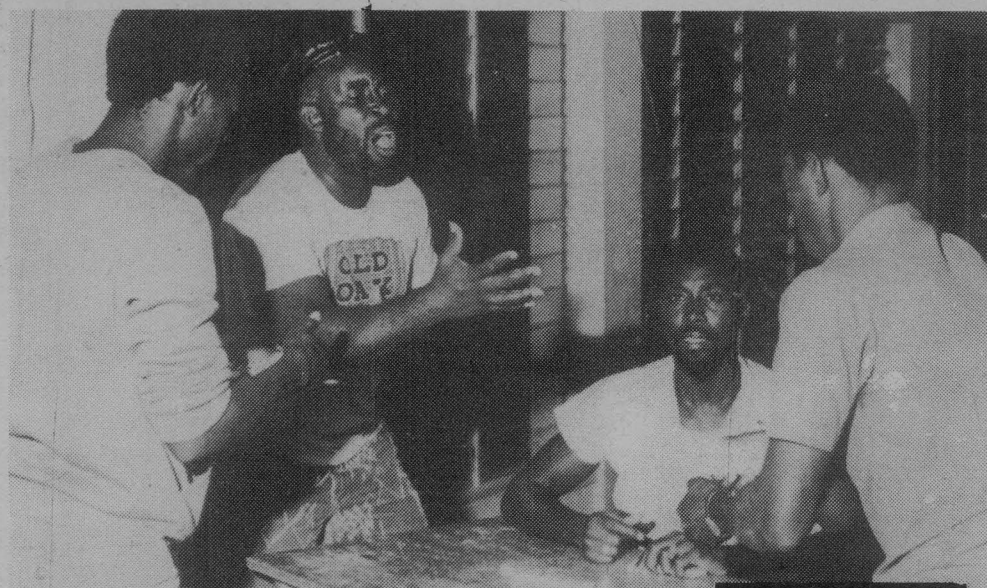

HIGH RISE

THE Pinelands Creative Workshop presents a 90-minute play called High Rise, today at 7 p.m. at the Parkinson Memorial School.

The play, which will run for two weekends, was scripted by playwright Anthony Hinkson and is directed by Dorsie Boyce.

It examines the impact of Government's housing schemes on the lives of people who have been "uprooted" from their place of birth and resettled in these areas.

The 16-member cast conducted the research for this documentary piece of drama by interviewing residents affected by resettlement.

Pinelands Creative Workshop hopes to take the show to St. Vincent in March.

Two-man show at Museum

THE TWO-MAN ART SHOW Personal Views continues at the Barbados Museum and will close next week Friday.

The canvases are mounted by two leading young artists, Ras Ishi and Ras Akym I, National Art Collection Foundation award winners.

Over 40 paintings covering

a wide spectrum of the Caribbean folk experience are stylised and done in flashingly bold colours in oil and acrylic.

According to the artists the aim is to give expression to historical and contemporary themes in the most simple way.

This is the first time these two have come together for one show; they have been working apart for several years. Yet, there are striking similarities in their work, the use of colour and shapes.

The works for the most part are recent.

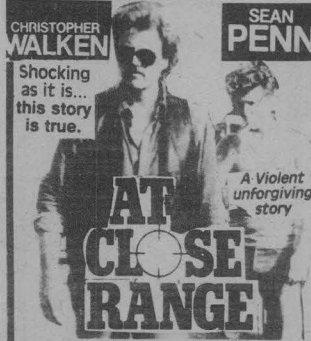
