Pinelands bring interviews to stage

PINELANDS CREATIVE WORKSHOP stages a two-hour drama called *The Interviews* at the Parkinson Memorial School from November 20 to 22.

The play examines the various ways in which youths are frustrated when seeking to fill advertised vacancies, and the bold-faced attempts by some employers to exploit these desperate job seekers.

Several of these applicants, who are prepared to do anything — to literally cut one another's throats through character assassination — to get the job, are brought on stage.

The unfolding plot critically looks at the situation, calling into question promises made to alleviate the unemployment problem and how these promises are attempted to be fulfilled.

Written by Anthony Hinkson, and directed by Dorsie Boyce, the play continues the following weekend. Tickets are on sale at the Global Travel Agency, Prince Alfred Street; Hole-in-The-Wall in Phillips Road; and Dian Canteen in Wildey.
